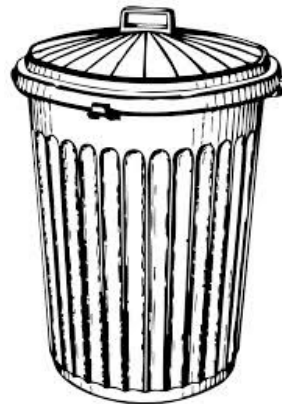

## Garbage Can Tool

With TOOLBOX, we teach children to imagine having an invisible Garbage Can to throw mean words into.

How many times have you told your child to “Just ignore him!” Easier said than done.

- Think of mean stuff as “garbage” that can be placed in a Garbage Can.
- Visualize a garbage can as big as needed to get rid of negative thoughts or actions of others.
- Remind each other to use your Garbage Can when conflicts arise.
- Help your children figure out if an event is important enough to deal with or something they can “just toss in and walk on by.”
